NZRCA Executive Meeting – November 2016

Communication Bulletin

On Wednesday 16th November 2016, the NZRCA Executive held a meeting to discuss a number of current outstanding issues and matters. Please see the following for what was discussed and decided on at this meeting.

- Pro 12 Class – Remit 10 from the 2016 NZRCA AGM for Pro 12 class to be reduced to 5 minutes. As per the NZRCA Constitution “8.1.a The Board may with consultation from the member clubs revert a rule change back to the previous year if that rule is deemed to be detrimental to the sport.” the NZRCA Executive have voted in favour of reverting the decision from the AGM and the Pro 12 class will revert back to the 2016 NZRCA rules being 8 Minutes.
- 8th Scale Offroad Nationals – Blenheim have been awarded the hosting of the 2017 I.C Off-Road Nationals (8th – 12th March 2017)

Nelson have been awarded the hosting rights of the 2017 8th Scale (Including 4wd SC Truck) EP Off-Road Nationals (Dates TBA)

- 21.5T Spec Motor Approval – The NZRCA have through a tender process selected the Reds Racing 21.5T (Model Number MTTE0013) as the Spec Motor for the Touring Stock Class. The cost of these motors shall be \$99.95 (subject to future movement through exchange rates) More information on ordering and availability will be released shortly once we work out the finer details with Reds RC.
- F1 Class – as the intention of Remit 12 from the 2016 NZRCA AGM for 21.5T Spec Motor was for the Touring Stock Class, the NZRCA Executive have voted in favour of reverting to the 2016 NZRCA Rule A7 for the F1 Class.
- Stock Touring Class – It has been suggested that for the 2017 NZRCA EP On-Road Nationals, the NZRCA look at trialling controlling the number of sets of tires a competitor may use once qualifying begins. Competitors are not limited to any brand or temperature tire, but once qualifying starts they are limited to running only 2 full sets which will be marked and checked throughout scrutineering.
- LiveTime – The NZRCA has begun the process of setting up the LiveTime account and hopes to have this completed asap. Currently 9 clubs have responded to request access to this software. Further communication will be sent to clubs once we receive our account log-on information from LiveTime.
